Fun and Games

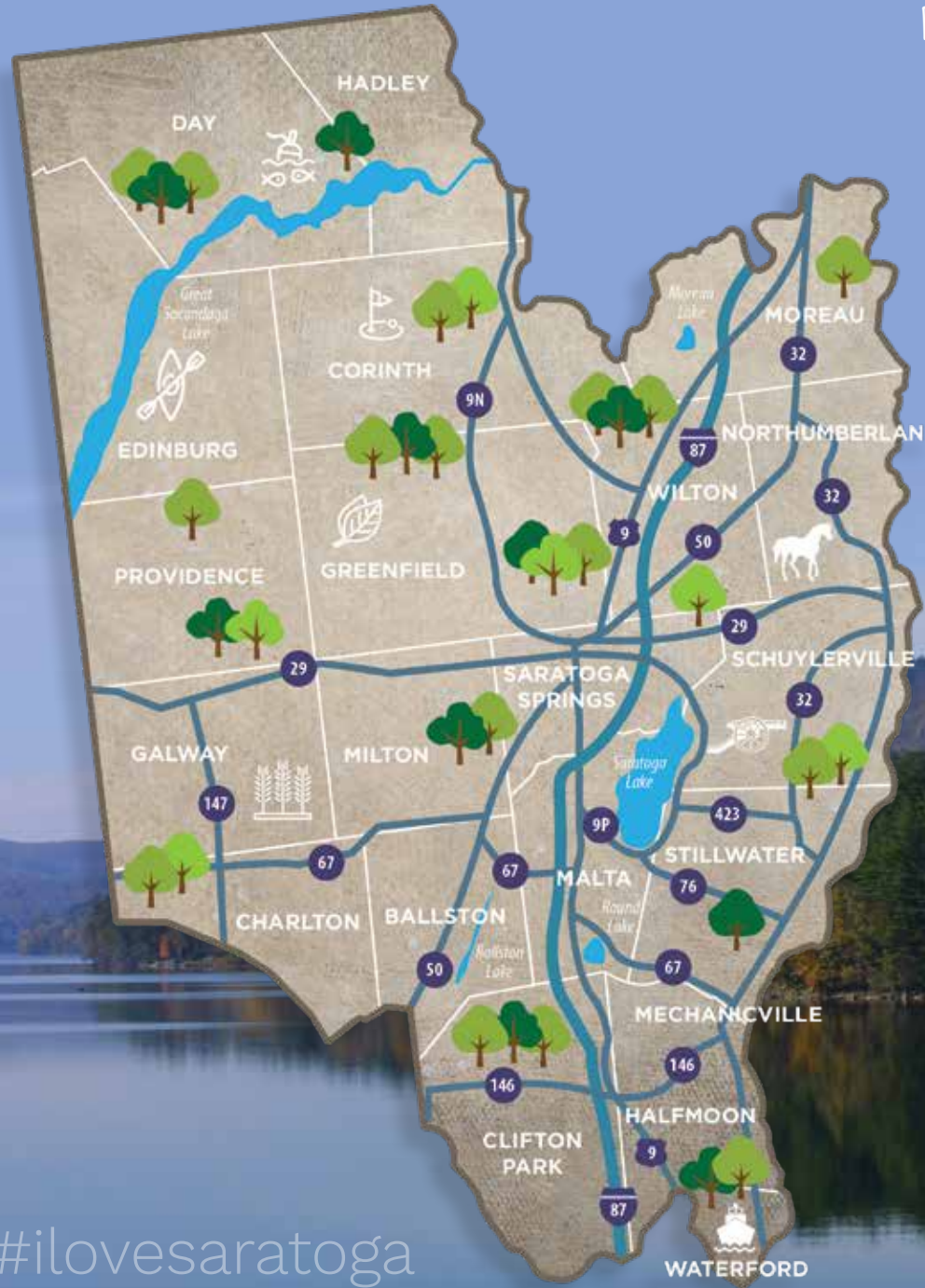
If it's sports you're interested in, we've got plenty to keep you happy. There are 14 golf courses in the area, including courses that win national awards for excellence.
